Section 1 – Wines

Judging will be on Sunday, August 15th, after 12noon

Section Rules:

1. Wines entered for competition must be amateur wine, home produced under regulations of Park 540 of the Code of Federal Regulations.
2. All wines must be produced and bottled by the exhibitor. Wines may be from any year's grapes, grape concentrate, fruit, fruit juice, honey or other fermentable.
3. All wines must be sealed in a 750mL or liter bottle. Bottles must be corked with standard wine corks or screw caps.
4. Bottles entered must be labeled as follows (typed or print): year of fermentation, name of wine (if applicable: name(s) of grapes, fruit(s), honey or other fermentable.) If blend, approximate percentage of components.
5. Bottles will be covered to not disclose names of exhibitors.
6. All entries must enter the Fairgrounds on Sunday, August 15th from 8:00am until 12:00noon. Please bring entries to the Vegetable Hall.
7. Exhibitors may enter only one (1) entry per class.

6. Exhibitors may enter only one (1) entry per class.
