◆◆◆◆◆ Department Rules ◆◆◆◆◆

Exhibitors must adhere to the IAFE Code of Ethics. Exhibitors must adhere to the Harford Fair General Rules. Please read all General and Department Rules before making entries

1. To enter: go to www.harfordfair.com, click on the link and follow the instructions to enter online or use the Rabbit Entry Blank below or in the online Harford Fair Premium Book and **please include an entry fee of \$1.00 per animal.**
2. **All Rabbits will be judged by the latest rules and standards of the American Rabbit Breeder's Association.**
3. All rabbits must have a permanent legible ear mark. All ear marks must be listed on the entry form.
4. After the entry deadline of August 1, changes or substitutions will only be allowed within the same specific class (i.e. breed, sex, age, and variety). Changes made by made through the Secretary's Office until August 9th.
5. Rabbits will be fed and watered by capable help during the week of the Harford Fair, but the Harford Agricultural Society will not be responsible for the loss of any rabbit.
6. Rabbits must be in good health. Any rabbit exhibiting signs of disease or stress (e.g. runny eyes or nose, poor flesh condition, or extreme molt) will be sent home.
7. Entries will be accepted in the order they are received until such time as the cooping capacity has been reached.
8. If cooping capacity is reached, exhibitors will be limited to 20 rabbits for exhibition.
9. In Heavy Breeds, maturing over 10 pounds (indicated by an *), classes will be: Senior – 8 months and over, Intermediate – 6-8 months, and Junior – 3-6 months). The Regular Breed Classes will be Senior – 6 months and over and Junior – 3-6 months. Weight limits per class depends on the breed. For questions, call the Superintendent.
10. Only rabbits entered as exhibits can be sold, but **CANNOT** leave the Fairgrounds until 10:00pm on Saturday night. Bunnies that are 6 weeks old to 3 months old **CANNOT BE SOLD** – even from the Doe & Litter Exhibit.
11. The Meat Pen Entries can only be sold as a pen.
12. The decision of the Superintendent is final.

❖❖❖❖ 2021 Health Requirements ❖❖❖❖

Pennsylvania Rabbits:

- 1) All animals must be free of infectious and contagious disease.

Out of State Rabbits: For Out of State rabbits that originate from a Commonwealth, State, Territory, or Country where Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease (RHD) has NOT been diagnosed in the prior twelve (12) months or there is no reasonable suspicion it exists:

- 1) All animals must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI), issued within 30 days prior to the date of importation. The CVI must remain on the Fairgrounds with the exhibitor and be available for inspection at any time.
- 2) All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this must be printed on the CVI.

For Out of State rabbits that originate from a Commonwealth, State, Territory, or Country where RHD has been diagnosed in the prior twelve (12) months or there is reasonable suspicion it exists:

- 1) No rabbits or their products, such as, meat, pelts, hides, carcasses or other items, and no equipment, exposed feed, forages, or conveyances or other items or associated materials may enter the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania from a Commonwealth, State, Territory, or Country where Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease (RHD) has been diagnosed in the prior twelve (12) months or there is a reasonable suspicion it exists unless they meet the following requirements:
 - (a) All live rabbits must be accompanied by an ICVI and must be examined by an accredited veterinarian within the seventy-two (72) hours prior to the date of shipment to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The ICVI must include statements by an accredited veterinarian certifying that:
 - (i) All rabbits in the shipment have been examined for and found free of infectious, contagious or communicable diseases;
 - (ii) All rabbits have originated from a single premises that has no signs of infectious, contagious or communicable disease in rabbits;
 - (iii) There have been no movements of rabbits onto the premises of origin within the 90 days prior to the date of shipment; and
 - (iv) The rabbits have had no contact with wild or captive rabbits other than their cohorts in the 90 days prior to the date of shipment.
 - (b) No rabbits or their products, such as, meat, pelts, hides, carcasses or other items, and no equipment, exposed feed or conveyances or other items or associated materials may enter the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania from a premises exposed to, contaminated with or known to be affected with RHD, or where there is a reasonable suspicion the disease exists or the rabbits have been exposed to or infected with RHD.
