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◆◆◆◆◆ Department Rules ◆◆◆◆◆

Exhibitors must adhere to the IAFF Code of Ethics. Exhibitors must adhere to the Harford Fair General Rules. Please read all General and Department Rules before making entries.

1. To enter: go to www.harfordfair.com, click on the link and follow the instructions to enter online or use the Horse Entry Blank below or in the online Harford Fair Premium Book and please include the entry fee of \$20.00 per animal (for horses staying Sunday, August 15th – Saturday, August 21st).
2. *The rules printed herein are made a part of the conditions under which all entries of exhibitors are made. Exhibitors are respectfully requested to read them carefully, thereby avoiding any confusion before, during and after the Fair.*
3. Horses to enter Sunday, August 15th, after 1:30pm to Monday, August 16th at 2:00pm. Upon your arrival at the fairgrounds, check in with one of the superintendents who will direct you to the stalls or space your stock is to occupy.
4. If you desire any information concerning the business of the exhibition, pay no attention to rumors or hearsay, but go directly to the superintendents who will take pleasure in giving you all the information you desire.
5. If stabling facilities are filled prior to closing date, we will close halter class entries at that point.
6. All entries must be made by the owner, and no animal will be admitted or stabled unless properly entered. If someone else will be showing the horse, note name on entry blank.
7. **There will be a limit of two (2) horses per owner who must enter & participate in halter classes or be turned away next year. This applies to all saddle horses on the fairgrounds Sunday, August 15th to Sunday, August 22nd, 2021.**
8. No stallions born before January 1, 2021 will be allowed on the fairgrounds. This only applies to the horses staying for the week.
9. All entries must be broke to tie & lead, or be disqualified.
10. No one under the age of 18 years will be allowed to show stallions.
11. Registered horses & ponies must be shown in the registered section and can only be entered under one breed.
12. **Any animal that appears to be sick or not serviceably sound, will be excused from fairgrounds.** Decision of the superintendents will be final.
13. For horses staying Sunday, August 15th thru Saturday August 21st, a fee of \$20 per animal will be charged.
14. A number will be assigned to each animal upon entry. That number must be displayed whenever the animal is shown. Entry number may be picked up from the Superintendents after stall assignment.
15. All stalls must be cleaned and limed before leaving the Fairgrounds. Entries staying on the fairgrounds from Tuesday to Saturday may be allowed to leave Saturday night with the superintendent's permission or must leave Sunday, August 22nd by 10am. This will be strictly enforced.
16. Anyone making entries and failing to show without notifying superintendents will be disqualified for the following two years.
17. Only original bedding will be furnished. All entries must furnish their own hay, grain, straw, wood chips, &/or sawdust.
18. The superintendents reserve the right to change the order of classes before or during the fair. **Horses stabled for the week must enter the Halter Classes.**
19. The decisions of the judges will be final.
20. All attendants in charge of animals will be subject to the orders of the superintendents. Any owner neglecting to properly feed, and water his/her animal(s) will be required to take his/her animal(s) home.
21. All exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience on the part of the exhibitor, owner, rider, or driver to the judges and/or other officials, will result in the disqualification of the animal. The owner shall thereby forfeit his/her entry fee and all premium awards.
22. Fire Law regulations prohibit the roping from aisles or any parts of aisles.
23. **NO SMOKING** at any time in the horse barns.
24. **No horses are permitted on fairgrounds beyond the Horse Barn.** All horses must be exercised in the arena, not in the barn area.
25. No one is to let a horse loose in the arena. Horses must either be ridden or on a lunge line.
26. Helmets must be worn by all exhibitors, ages 18 and under as of January 1st, 2021.

❖❖❖❖ 2021 Health Rules Requirements ❖❖❖❖

Requirements for Equine Animals (Pennsylvania) Entering the Fairgrounds:

- 1) A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI or "health certificate") issued after May 1, 2021 is required. The CVI must remain on the Fairgrounds with the exhibitor and be available at any time for inspection.
 - 2) All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this is required on the CVI (the statement is preprinted on the CVI).
 - 3) All animals must test negative for EIA (Equine Infectious Anemia) by an official test (negative Coggins Test), completed after January 1, 2021. Laboratory test results must accompany each animal (a copy of the original lab report is acceptable). Foals less than six months of age accompanied by a dam which meets the above requirements are exempt from EIA testing requirements. If the foal is not accompanied by the dam, a copy of the dam's test results must accompany the foal.
 - 4) A current rabies vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian is required for animals three (3) months of age and older. If a mare was currently vaccinated against rabies when she foaled, the foal is not required to be vaccinated until six (6) months of age. All rabies vaccinated equine animals must be accompanied by a rabies vaccination certificate (or a copy), or the rabies vaccination information must be included on the CVI.
 - 5) It is required that equine animals are also vaccinated against: EEE & WEE (Eastern & Western Equine Encephalomyelitis), Equine Influenza, Tetanus and Rhino (EVH-1 & EVH-4) by using a 5-way vaccination. It is **recommended** that equine animals are also vaccinated against West Nile Virus and Potomac.
- ### Requirements for Out of State Equine Animals Entering the Fairgrounds (in addition to the above listed requirements):
- 6) A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued within 30 days prior to the start of the 2021 Harford Fair. If an animal comes from a state in which Vesicular Stomatitis (VS) has been identified, or a bordering state, the CVI shall include a statement verifying "All animals identified on this CVI have been examined and found to be free from Vesicular Stomatitis. During the past 90 days, these animals have neither been exposed to VS nor located within 10 miles of a site where VS has been diagnosed."
 - 7) If an equine animal has resided in a state in which Piroplasmiasis has been identified for a cumulative total of 30 days or more within the six (6) months preceding the date of entry into Pennsylvania, that animal must test-negative for Piroplasmiasis on a competitive enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay (c-ELISA) test, or a PA Department of AG approved equivalent test, with the test occurring within 30 days preceding entry into Pennsylvania. The written laboratory test report, confirming compliance with the requirement described above, shall accompany the equine animal to the Fairgrounds; and the test date and test results shall be written on the CVI.

HORSES MUST BE HITCHED TO A CART OR SUITABLE VEHICLE

Driving Classes will be judged on the following criteria:

1. The suitability of harness & equipment.
2. The attire of driver (e.g. English or Western Show attire).
Apron and gloves optional.
3. Driver must carry whip in hand.
4. The participants will enter into show arena and proceed to the rail at a walk.
5. Drivers are expected to show their horses at the following gaits:
 - a. Walk: free moving, flat footed, brisk
 - b. Collected Trot: Slow trot, sharp and well-balanced.
 - c. Working Trot: fast trot, free movement, lengthening of stride.
 - d. Backup: willing to back up at least four steps
6. Unsportsmanlike conduct &/or abusive language will not be tolerated.
7. Novice Division – never won a blue ribbon.
8. Novice Drivers must be accompanied by an adult in the cart. Novice Drivers must have a handler at the horse's head when lined up.
9. Junior Division – 14 years of age and younger
10. Junior Drivers must have a handler at the horse's head when lined up.
11. Open Division – no age restrictions
12. Exhibitors ages 18 and under, as of January 1, MUST wear a helmet.

Rules & Regulations for Closed Exhibitors Show and for Open Show.

Also, refer to the Rules & Regulations on pages 25, 29 & 37.

1. Participants 18 years of age and under may ride in Youth & Open Events.
2. Age requirements will be based on the child's actual age as of January 1, 2021.
3. No reimbursement for gate admission.
4. No abusive language.
5. Proper show attire required to be worn by all exhibitors entering the show ring: boots are required to be worn by all riders. Tank tops, cutoffs, & muscle shirts are NOT acceptable. Hats are mandatory for Judged Classes only.
6. Hard hats must be worn by those 18 years of age and under in any riding classes.
7. A number will be assigned to each rider/animal upon entry. That number must be displayed in the middle of the rider's back and on the rider's saddle for games whenever the animal or rider is showing.
8. All exhibitors and animals will be subject to orders of the judges and/or superintendents and those decisions will be final.
9. To be eligible to ride in a specific class, rider must be signed up at least three classes ahead.
10. Anything that is not covered in the above will be examined and decided upon by the Show Committee.
