◆◆◆◆◆ Department Rules ◆◆◆◆◆

Exhibitors must adhere to the IAFE Code of Ethics. Exhibitors must adhere to the Harford Fair General Rules. Please read all General and Department Rules before making entries.

1. To enter: go to www.harfordfair.com, click on the link and follow the instructions to enter online or use the Dairy Entry Blank below or in the online Harford Fair Premium Book and **please include an entry fee of \$3.00 per animal.**
2. **ALL ENTRY FORMS** must be accompanied by the registration name and number of the animal, and the name of the owner, breeder, and dam. **LIMIT OF 20 ANIMALS PER FARM OR AS SPACE PERMITS.**
3. Bulls and/or any animal with horns will NOT be accepted in any breed class.
4. Registration papers (transferred, not pending) and Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) must accompany the animal and must be checked and approved before the animal can be unloaded at the Fairgrounds. Animals to be shown in the Red and White Holstein Classes must follow eligibility as defined by the RWDCA Show Specifications. Animals to be shown in the Black and White Holstein Classes must follow eligibility as defined by the PA Holstein Association.
5. All youth animals must be owned (or leased) by the exhibitor by June 1st of this year. The date of sale on the registration certificate will be used as the date of ownership or lease in all cases.
6. Exhibitors are responsible for knowing when their stock will be judged and are expected to display or parade their animals as directed. Failure to present their animals at the ring when called will result in disqualification.
7. Exhibitors are expected to accept stall assignments without controversy and cooperate with the Superintendents in every way to preserve the educational value of the show. If requests are made for stall preferences, they must be made to the Superintendent(s) no less than one week before the Fair. No stalls will be promised, but we will do our best.
8. All animals shown in group classes must also compete in the individual classes. Dairy cattle can only exhibit in one (1) breed class.
9. Only original bedding will be furnished. All exhibitors must furnish their own hay. Straw will be available for sale on the Fairgrounds.
10. Milk disposal – milk may only be discarded in a container/vessel designated by the Superintendents or be removed from the grounds by the exhibitor. Milk cannot be discarded in any other location (i.e. wash rack drainage system).
11. If an exhibitor is unable to tend his/her animals during the Fair, you must contact a Dairy Superintendent **IN WRITING**, providing the name of the person responsible in your absence. Failure to do so will forfeit all or part of the premium and could result in removal from the Fairgrounds.
12. If animals must be withdrawn two or three days before the opening day of the Fair, you must contact a Dairy Superintendent(s).
13. All open show colored breeds must remain on the Fairgrounds until the completion of the colored breed shows on Wednesday. All youth and open show Holsteins must remain on the Fairgrounds until 10:00pm on Saturday night. If animals are brought in before Monday, August 16, you must notify a Dairy Superintendent of the animal's arrival time.
14. **YOUTH EXHIBITORS** – must be 21 years of age or younger. Entries **MUST BE SHOWN** by the owner/lessee to be eligible for youth competition. ANY exceptions must be approved by the Superintendents prior to show date.
15. **YOUTH EXHIBITORS** – will be limited to one (1) entry per class.
16. **YOUTH EXHIBITORS** – **MUST** be able to lead, control, and handle their own entries to be eligible for youth premiums. If youth are unable to handle their own animals, as determined by the Dairy Superintendents, they will be eligible for Open Show Premiums only.
17. All bedding must be forked back two feet from the front of the stalls before 6:00am on Sunday. Animals housed on the South End of the Dairy Barn must completely clean out their bedding by 6:00am on Sunday.

❖❖❖❖ 2021 Health Requirements ❖❖❖❖

Pennsylvania Cattle:

- 1) All animals must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued after May 1, 2021. The CVI must remain on the Fairgrounds with the exhibitor and be available for inspection at any time.
 - 2) All animals must be free of infectious, contagious, or parasitic diseases, and a statement of this is required on the CVI (is pre-printed on CVI).
 - 3) All animals must have an official ear tag or a breed registration tattoo.
 - 4) All animals over three (3) months of age (except market cattle) must have a current (within 180 days of show) rabies vaccination show proof of vaccination with: a) a valid rabies certificate (or copy of): or b) the rabies vaccination information must be included on the CVI
 - 5) A Tuberculosis test is not required.
 - 6) A Brucellosis test is not required.
 - 7) All animals must be immunized against IBR, P13, BRSV, and BVD. A statement of this must be included on the CVI.
- ***Special note – Animals that have never been vaccinated against BVD or have not been vaccinated against BVD during the previous 12 months must receive: a) one dose of modified live virus vaccine given at least 15 days and not more than 180 days before the Show; or b) two doses of killed virus vaccine, given two to four weeks apart, with the last dose at least 15 days, and not more than 180 days before the Show. **The date of the last modified live virus vaccination, or the dates of the last two killed virus vaccinations must be recorded on the CVI.** Hyper-immune serum may not be used as a substitute for the above vaccination requirement. **Animals without proper vaccination will not be allowed on the Fairgrounds.**

Out of State Cattle:

- 1) All animals must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued within 30 days prior to the start of the Harford Fair. If an animal comes from a state in which Vesicular Stomatitis (VS) has been identified, or a bordering state, the CVI shall include a statement verifying “All animals identified on this CVI have been examined and found to be free from Vesicular Stomatitis. During the past 90 days, these animals have neither been exposed to VS nor located within 10 miles of a site where VS has been diagnosed.”
- 2) All animals must be free of infectious, contagious, or parasitic diseases, and a statement of this is required on the CVI (is pre-printed on CVI).
- 3) All animals must have an official ear tag or a breed registration tattoo.

- 4) All animals over three (3) months of age (except market cattle) must have a current (within 180 days of show) rabies vaccination show proof of vaccination with: a) a valid rabies certificate (or copy of): or b) the rabies vaccination information must be included on the CVI.
- 5) Tuberculosis: No test is required for animals originating from “Accredited Free” states. All animals originating from states designated “Modified Accredited Advanced” must test negative within 60 days prior to date of importation. The negative test results and the date of the test must be included on the CVI or the animal must be accompanied by a negative test report (or copy of). All animals originating from states designated “Modified Accredited” must originate from herds in which all animals 12 months of age or older be test negative within the 12 months prior to the date of importation; and the individual animals to be imported (all ages) are test negative within the 60 days prior to importation and at least 60 days after the negative whole herd test. The test results and the date of the test must be included on the CVI or the animal must be accompanied by a negative test report (or copy).
- 6) Brucellosis: No test is required for animals originating from a Brucellosis-free state or are members of a Certified Brucellosis-free herd. Unvaccinated animals over 8 months of age and all animals over 14 months of age originating from Brucellosis Class A, B and C states shall be Brucellosis test negative within 60 days of the date of the show. The test results and date of the test must be included on the CVI or the animal must be accompanied by a negative laboratory test report (or copy of). An approved laboratory in the state of origin or Canada shall conduct an official blood test for Brucellosis, and the imported test-eligible animals shall be negative on an officially approved Brucellosis test.

Entry deadline: August 1

Use Dairy Entry Blank or enter online – one owner per form – one entry per class.

Youth Dairy Cattle entries must also be entered in the Open Dairy Shows.

All youth entries must be shown by the owner/lessee to be eligible for Youth Competition.

Any exceptions must be approved by a Dairy Superintendent prior to the Show date.
